<b>Job Summary</b>	Under the general direction of the Manger of Life Support Systems the Tech is responsible for the care and maintenance of the Life Support systems to which they have been assigned.
<b>Essential Functions</b>	1. Under the guidance of the Manger of Life Support Systems performs all operational tasks to assure the proper operation of all life support systems equipment to ensure the delivery of an adequate supply of high quality water to all exhibit and animal holding areas. 2. Reports unusual conditions or mechanical problems that need to be addressed 3. Ability to work in outdoor weather conditions and requires walking and climbing on wet uneven surfaces. 4. Able to enter confined spaces to make repairs and operate a fire hose to clean sediment. 5. Able to use shovel and pick in locating piping systems 6. Able to work with PVC pipe and solvents 7. Able to paint using standard practices 8. Able to follow directions given for general Life Support Systems 9. Ability to lift 50 pounds. 10. Performs other duties as assigned.
<b>Other Duties and Responsibilities</b>	This position has no supervisory responsibilities.
<b>Knowledge, Skills and Abilities</b>	Knowledge of and ability to use computers and standard, commonly accepted computer programs is required. Skill in the reading and use of blueprints is necessary. Ability to work under limited supervision, both independently and in a team environment.

Knowledge of maintenance and preventative practices for pumps and motors and electrical and plumbing systems is preferred.
